

PW: How do I create a customized course assessment test?

SYMPTOMS

How do I create an assessment test for my custom learning path?

CAUSE

You have created a learning path that meets your needs better than the existing published activities with assessments.

SOLUTION

This procedure assumes that you have already created a custom learning path in Learning Resource Management, such as "Math 9".

1. Go to Learning Resource Management.
2. Select **Create > choose Lesson > enter a title, such as "Math 9 Assessment" > select Course Assessment Test from the lesson type drop-down list > Finish.**
3. Use **Set Filter** to locate and highlight your custom learning path (such as Math 9).
4. Select **Properties > Set Filter > deselect the activity type on the right > enter the name of the custom assessment test activity you created in step 2** (such as Math 9 Assessment) **in the Title Match field > OK.** If you don't see the custom assessment, work with the filter settings until you do.
5. When you see the custom assessment on the left side, double-click it to the right side. Usually, it makes the most sense to move the assessment to the top of the list using the up arrow.
6. Optional: If you want to force learners to complete the assessment before starting any of the other activities in the learning path, select the first activity after the assessment, click **Prerequisites** below the list, then double-click the custom assessment to move it to the right side and click **OK.** Then repeat this for each of the other activities. Click **OK** when done.

This custom assessment test will draw questions from all of the activities in the custom learning path that have Course-Level Assessment mastery tests. Bear in mind that not all PLATO curricula have Course-Level Assessment mastery tests.
